



Writing Labs

If you have many papers to write in the semester and want to make a permanent weekly appointment with the same writing tutor, you can register for one of our Writing Labs and receive 1 unit of credit as well!

HOW DO I REGISTER?

Step 1. Enroll via PROWL. After Week 1, the LRC will automatically enroll you. The meeting time is determined when you make your appointment in Step 2.

Step 2. Go to the LRC to schedule your weekly appointment time with a tutor. Talk to Ann Stenglein (or call 310-338-2726) astengle@lmu.edu. Lab appointments begin Week 3, so you must have your weekly appointment set up by the end of Week 2.

HOW DO I KNOW WHAT TO REGISTER FOR?

If you are enrolled in ENGL 100, → Register for **ENGL 101**

If you are enrolled in ENGL 110, → Register for **ENGL 111**

If you are enrolled in ENGL 130, 140, 150 or have many writing assignments from other courses → Register for **ENGL 115**.

WHAT WILL WE WORK ON?

In the weekly 50-minute sessions your tutor can help you

- Understand the assignment.
- Generate more ideas and support for your topic.
- Find appropriate library sources.
- Write a terrific thesis.
- Plan out your paper.
- Revise your drafts for content and development of your argument.
- Learn effective editing and proofreading techniques.
- Learn how to properly document and cite your sources.

You set the agenda, so be sure to bring the paper you are working on and any necessary class notes, books, etc.

Remember, you receive 1 unit of credit for these labs, so attendance is very important. You must sign up before the 3rd week of classes! If you've missed the sign-up date, you can still schedule an appointment with a writing tutor for up to 3 weeks at a time and then reschedule every 3 weeks for the remainder of the semester. However, you won't receive a unit of credit for this.
