

2009-2010 LMU Blackout Holidays and Tier One Dates:

University Holidays:

Loyola Marymount University defines these dates as university holidays. No events may take place during these dates since the University is closed and no support staff is available:

- September 7, 2009 – Labor Day
- November 25 through November 29, 2009 – Thanksgiving Day, Friday, Saturday and Sunday of Thanksgiving Weekend
- December 24 2009 through January 1, 2010 – Christmas Leave
- January 18, 2010 -- Martin Luther King Jr. Day
- March 31, 2010 -- Cesar Chavez Day
- April 1 through April 4, 2010 – Holy Thursday, Good Friday, Easter Saturday and Easter Sunday
- May 31, 2010 -- Memorial Day
- July 5, 2010 -- Independence Day

University Tier 1 Blackout Dates:

Loyola Marymount University designates full priority to these events during the year and restricts all other events or functions from occurring on these dates due to their size, scope and logistical complexity.
