The Application Process

February 14th - March 6th

Complete your online application, electronically acknowledge the License Agreement, and pay your non-refundable \$400 processing fee.

Open Houses & Building Tours

February 22nd from 6pm-8pm

Tour the buildings to learn about your options. Meet in front of the buildings you are interested in for a feel of the community!

Roommate Pairing Social

February 22nd from 8pm-9pm

Come meet other students and form roommate groups! Meet in the back lobby of Rains Hall to mingle with potential roommates.

Priority Drawing

March 12th & 13th

Draw your priority number! The lower the number, the earlier you will be able to choose your room.

Room Selection

March 20th - 23rd

In the online application, the group leader selects exactly where the roommate group will live.

Theme Housing

Pursue your education in a living environment suited to your passions! There are several theme housing options available. Interested students must complete the Housing Selection application and the application for the theme community. Theme housing applications are available in Student Housing Online Services and are due on February 10th.

Center for Service and Action House - This community is committed to incorporating LMU into local service projects.

Honors - This community in Rains and Leavey 6 creates a learning environment where students in the Honors Program can get the support they need while engaged in this rigorous academic program.

International House - This community works to promote diversity, cultural awareness and support for international students.

McCarthy Experience in Service and Action (MESA) - This community is passionate about service and the students involved work with the local community.

Rains Intercultural Suite Experience (RISE) - This community engages in intercultural and social justice issues.

The Application Process

February 14th - March 6th

To apply for housing, follow these three steps:

1. Complete the online application by logging into MyLMU. Under System Logins, click on Student Housing Online Services, then click the Apply tab. In the application, you will select a non-refundable meal plan for the academic year and create your roommate group.
2. Electronically acknowledge the terms and conditions of the License Agreement in the application. We encourage you to save a copy of it for your records.
3. Pay the \$400 housing processing fee at Student Accounts. This fee is **non-refundable** and will be credited toward your fall housing charges. Since transactions may take two business days to process, we recommend you pay by March 2nd.

The Housing Guarantee

Guaranteed Student Status

First-year students who currently live on campus and complete the Housing Selection Process are guaranteed housing for their sophomore year.

Non - Guaranteed Student Status

Students who live off campus and rising juniors and seniors will go through the Housing Selection Process for a chance to receive housing.

Roommate Groups

A roommate group may consist of one, two or four students of the same gender and same guarantee status. In order to create a group, one person, the group leader, must enter the pairing numbers of all roommates and verify the group in the application. The pairing number can be found in the application.

You may enter the process alone, but will have better odds in Priority Drawing and more options during Room Selection if you have a group of two or more. If you have not found a roommate, we encourage you to attend the Roommate Pairing Social on February 22nd in the back lobby of Rains.

Priority Drawing

March 12th & March 13th

- On March 12th and 13th, log in to Student Housing Online Services and draw your priority number. The lowest number drawn by any member of the roommate group becomes the group's priority number. This number will determine if and when the group may select a room during Room Selection. The lower the number, the earlier your appointment time will be.
- Please note that if you do not draw a number, a number will be automatically assigned to you.
- Appointment times and waitlist information will be available on Student Housing Online Services at 12pm on March 16th.
- If your status is non-guaranteed and your group does not draw a low enough number to receive an appointment, you will automatically be added to the housing waitlist. At that time, the roommate group is dissolved and each person is placed on the waitlist according to the individual number drawn. If you are on the waitlist and wish to cancel your application, you must fill out the online cancellation form found in Student Housing Online Services. If you cancel before you are assigned housing, the \$400 housing processing fee will be credited to your student account.



Room Selection

March 20th - March 23rd

Your appointment time indicates the earliest you are able to log in to Student Housing Online Services between March 20th and 23rd to select from available rooms. The group leader is the only person who can choose the room for the whole group. Once a selection is made, it cannot be changed until after the process ends.

You can visit the various buildings during the Open House and Building tours on February 22nd.
